- Individual members are either German citizens, or citizens of other countries, that have been accepted by the DWV as individual members.
 - Individual members receive all the publications of the DWV, may participate in all activities of the DWV and take part in general assemblies. However, they do not have the right to vote.
- Visiting member 475 EUR**
- A visiting member is a company or a person, which/who is currently inactive in Georgia.
 - After 12 months, accession to full membership required.
 - Visiting members receive all the publications of the DWV, can participate in all activities of the DWV, as well as take part in general assemblies. However, they do not have the right to vote.
